PSHE at Wylve Valley Primary School

Intent:

PSHE is at the core of what we do at Wylve Valley Primary School, as stated in our Vision, Values and Aims. In PSHE it is our belief that excellence in these core areas lead to excellence across the curriculum. Our PSHE curriculum will develop the "whole child" intellectually, morally, socially and spiritually. It is woven in to all that we do, through our Vision, Values and Aims. It is also given focus through weekly lesson time devoted to the subject. We provide our children with opportunities for them to learn about rights and responsibilities and appreciate what it means to be a member of a diverse society. Our children are encouraged to develop their sense of self-worth by playing a positive role in contributing to school life and the wider community.

Implementation:

PSHE at Wylve Valley Primary School is implemented using the JIGSAW programme which is a whole school approach. Progression in skills and knowledge in the subject is outlined in the PSHE progression grid. The curriculum for PSHE is delivered throughout the whole school.

The six topics covered are:

Being Me in My World;

Celebrating Difference;

Dreams and Goals;

Healthy Me;

Relationships;

Changing Me.

Learning in each topic then takes place during weekly whole class Jigsaw lessons which explore the different themes. These themes are also embedded through all other lessons and the whole school

day with everyone supporting and encouraging the children they interact with to use the skills they are developing and to make links to other areas of learning. The aims of PSHE and Jigsaw within Wylve Valley Primary School are to provide children with:

- accurate and relevant knowledge;
- opportunities to create personal understanding;
- opportunities to explore and challenge a range of values, attitudes, beliefs, rights and responsibilities;
- a range of skills and strategies to live a healthy, safe, fulfilling, responsible and balanced life.

Our PSHE programme deals with the diverse beliefs, values and attitudes that individuals and societies hold. It helps pupils to develop themselves, their understanding of the world, and their ability to communicate their feelings. Children at Wylve Valley Primary School also acquire an understanding and experiences of British values that are necessary if they are to make sense of their experiences, value themselves, respect others, appreciate differences and feel confident and informed as a British citizen.

Impact:

The impact of following this programme will be that the standards of attainment across the school will meet or exceed those which are expected of our children nationally. Children will demonstrate a healthy outlook towards school. Attendance will be good and behaviour will be exceptional. The children will demonstrate a willingness and ability to:

- Try new things;
- Work hard;
- Concentrate on given tasks;
- Push themselves;
- Use their imagination;
- Evaluate and improve their work;
- Understand others better;
- Not give up;
- Show a secure understanding of how to stay safe;
- Show a secure understanding of how to stay healthy;
- Show a secure understanding of how to develop good relationships;
- Develop a tolerance of others;
- Have an understanding of British Values.
